**NT Community Ed – Drivers' Education Winter Session**

The DRIVERS EDUCATION winter session begins Wednesday, January 2<sup>nd</sup> 2019. **Space is limited** and the **deadline to register is Wednesday, December 19<sup>th</sup>**.
